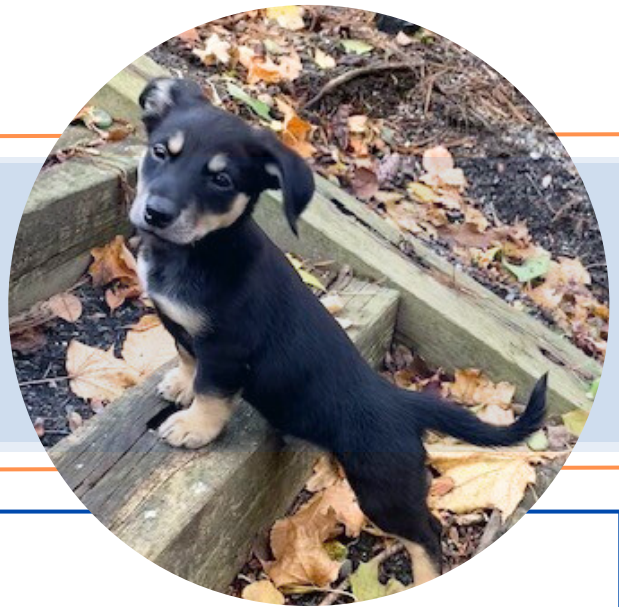


# Bruno

## AND NOW A FEW WORDS FROM MY FOSTER FAMILY...

Bruno is a puppy bundle of joy! His date of birth is unknown but best estimates place him at around 10 weeks old. He is a mixed breed/unknown and his coat is short and very soft. A CDRO vet estimates that his adult weight will be somewhere between 20-40 lbs. He is intelligent, very curious, confident and adventurous. Bruno is very affectionate and likes to cuddle but also has an independent side to him where he can go off and lay alone sometimes even in a different room unless he's busy snuggling with his little brother Rusty. Adopters should be aware that he is a high-energy dog and will need someone who is equally energetic and committed to his training and health as he is still very young. If he is not being monitored or engaged, he will find his own fun. He is a puppy, so chewing, curiosity and mischievous behaviour are all normal. Bruno is doing very well with his potty training and will require multiple scheduled bathroom breaks throughout the day (currently on a 30 mins schedule). At night he will settle pretty quickly into his crate and will generally remain there until early morning unless he starts to fuss in which case it's usually because he needs a potty break; after being taken out he settles back down to sleep quickly.

When Bruno is crated during the day or for car rides, he sometimes barks in protest however when ignored, he ceases the behaviour and settles, particularly if he has had some exercise time prior to and is tired. Potential adopters who live in apartments or attached homes need to be aware that he can be vocal. Bruno is incredibly food motivated. In fact, he devours his meals so quickly that he is currently being hand fed to slow down his consumption (perhaps a slow feeder bowl could be considered as another option). Although he does not need another dog in the home, Bruno is currently living with his litter brother and two other large breed dogs. He is highly social and likes to interact with people and other dogs so he would benefit from socialization and play dates. Don't let his cuteness distract you from the fact he is a high-energy puppy that requires a lot of work, training, walking, brain stimulation and play interacting. All vaccinations will be up to date for his age at the time of adoption. Neutering will be required after 9 months. Bruno is being fostered in Gatineau, Quebec. Meet and greets will be held in Gatineau and/or surrounding Ottawa area.
