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## AND NOW A FEW WORDS FROM MY FOSTER FAMILY...

Finnigan is a very sweet, calm and lovable pup. She loves to be near me and the other dogs in my home - she would prefer to always be on my lap but will go to her bed when directed...the bed has to be in the same room as me. She is not a fan of her crate and would prefer to sleep with her person. If her adopter wishes to crate train her, be aware that she will whine, squeak, squawk for long periods of time. I believe that is her behaviour when left alone in the home as well, unless she can be with another dog(s). She needs a home with patient humans because navigating the home and outdoor routines will take her time. She stays very close to my legs when I am moving around. Having easy access to the yard is helpful. She has taken a bit of time to learn the bathroom routines and will need a structured routine for those breaks to avoid accidents. Finn is not used to wearing a harness or walking on leash so she is learning how those things work. She definitely has separation anxiety and will need a person to be with her most of the time. If you live in an apartment her barking/whining could be problematic but if you are home most of the time, she would not be noisy. She is joining in with the singing (barking) with my dogs but is not appearing to be a barker on her own. She is a wonderful dog with funny quirks and will make an awesome pet for someone or a family living a low key lifestyle.
