Poppy has the pleasure of going to work every day and is the hit of the office. She has also attended several public events and has even gone shopping. As a result, she is well socialized with people, kids and other dogs. Poppy loves to play and be near her family so she will require a home that has another young dog for company and pawrents who will be home with her regularly. Her crate time is kept to 2 hour intervals for a maximum of 4 hours per day, with the exception of bedtime. It is important that her new family be able to maintain this schedule.
