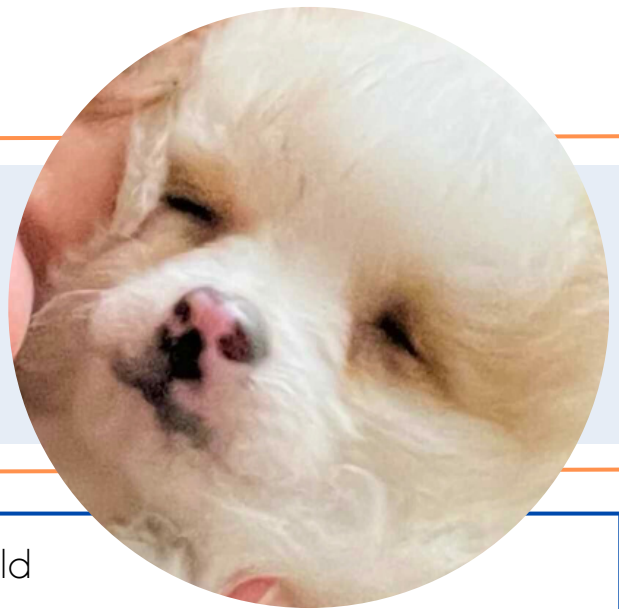


Ray

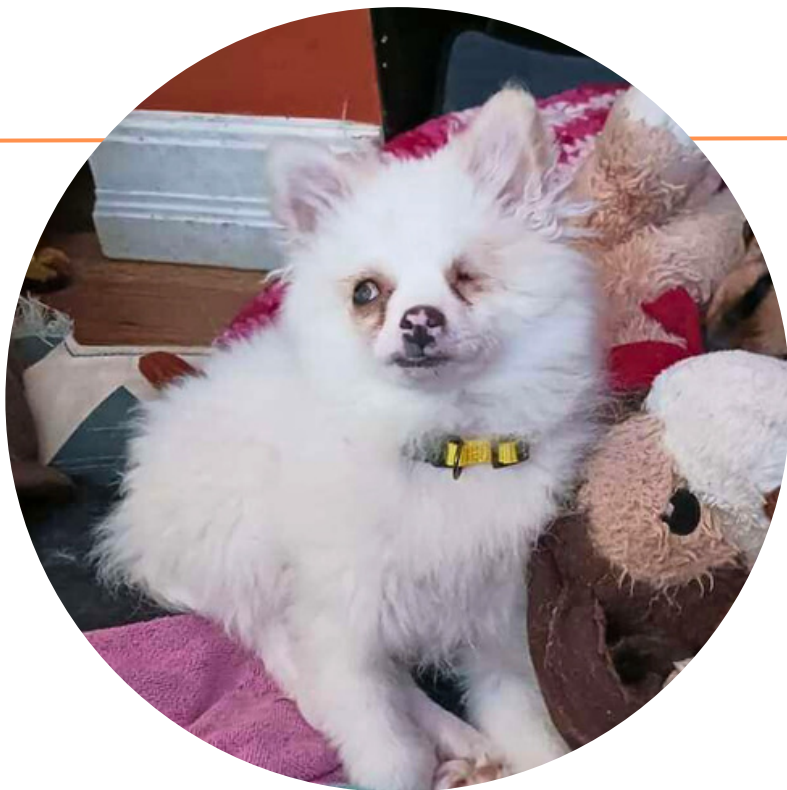
I LIKE...

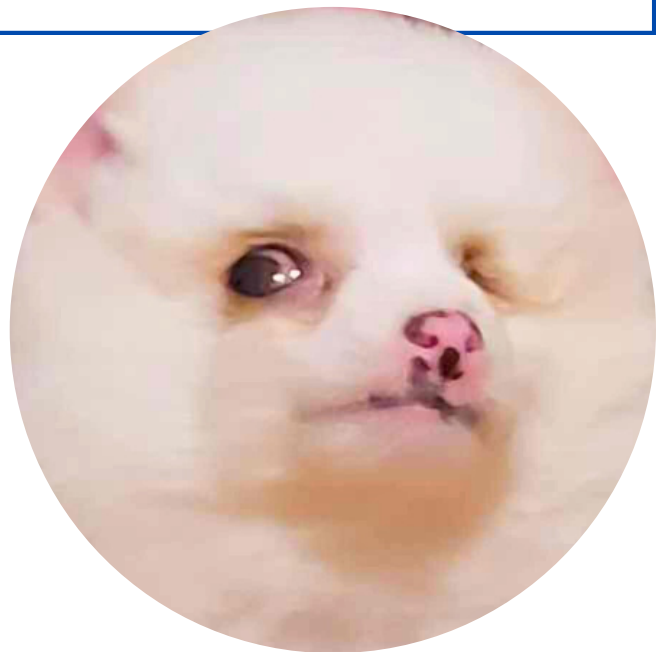

Ray doesn't really know much about the outside, and the feeling of snow, deck, or pavement are unfamiliar to him, but that's okay...being carried around to learn outside is fun for him. He is completely crate trained and sleeps through the night with a fluffy blanket with which he likes to make a nest. His training is the same as a fully-visual dog - touch is important along with verbal cues. He is a very, very smart boy.
